TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN.

GoldTrain Plus (GT+) is a nutritional, non-herbal supplement of vegetal origin that has neither side effects nor contraindications.

GT+ seems to work as an immuno-regulator (1).

GT+ usually stimulates the appetite of HIV+ and AIDS patients thereby causing a rapid weight increase and a boost of energy - especially in emaciated and weak patients. It normalizes the gastrointestinal function and stops diarrhea, coughing, night sweats and shivers (2,3,4).

GT+ prolongs the latent phase of the disease in asymptomatic HIV+ patients (4).

Patients with symptoms of AIDS who take GT+ experience a general feeling of well-being, display positive mood changes, recuperate their strength, return to normal and peaceful sleeping patterns, and their faces regain their normal colors (2,3,4,5).

The patients who have continued taking the maintenance dose of GT+ since 1993 have enjoyed a good quality of life. They work, participate in sports and conduct normal social lives (4).

Within a few weeks of taking GT+ exclusively, even very ill patients are able to emerge from their critical or terminal states. It is precisely with these life-threatened patients that immediate and dramatic effects can best be appreciated (2,4).

GT+ can be administered without interruption for a period of many years. The dose, however, may vary according to the physician's criteria and the patient's status. As the patient recovers, the dosage can gradually be decreased until reaching a maintenance dose.

Patients who have been taking GT+ for over twelve years have not shown adverse signs or side effects of any type (4).
